Earthquake in Nanggroe Aceh Darussalam Province, Indonesia

Reporting date and time

17 January 2005 (Monday) – 16.00 Hrs local time

Type of Emergency

Earthquake followed by tsunami.

Date of emergency incidence

26 December 2004 (Sunday), 07:58 hrs and 08:48 hrs local time. (Indonesia, Western Zone: + 7 GMT),
00:58:50 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC)

Casualties

- Total death is 114,978 and 12,132 missing (data from Ministry of Social, up to 17 January 2005)
- Death toll is reaching 95,000 and the missing are 77,000 (data from Ministry of Health dated 14 January 2005)
- Admission in the hospital as in-patients is 1,644, and out patients are 6,390 (*include the number of patients admitted in Hospital in Jakarta - List is available from MOH.*)
- IDPs estimated reaching to 610,373 people. (*List of number and location is available with the MOH.*)

Follow up activities and information

Ministry of Health

- Logistic and drug distribution still remain as major problem.
- In Coordination meeting from Bakornas (National Coordination Board for Disaster Response) decided that data of the death and in and out patients in hospital and health post will be under Ministry of Health's responsibility, data of IDPs will be Ministry of Social's responsibility, and data of Missing people will be under the commander post in Banda Aceh
- Ministry of Health also responsible for the schedule of the placement of the doctors and international assistance, medical equipment, drugs and hospital rehabilitation.
- Up to 16 January 2005, total coverage of measles vaccination is 16,000 children (6 months – 15 years old)

WHO Indonesia

- Minister of Health gave the compliment to WHO especially in good coordination and supports that had been given
- It had been discuss that WHO will put into consideration of rehabilitation and reconstruction of the health system in Banda Aceh.
