General Information on Banda Aceh

- At least 172 sub-districts and 1550 villages were destroyed

Follow up activities

Government

- Government prohibited unaccompanied children to leave Banda Aceh at least within a month to finish the registration.

MOH information

- Indonesia CDC had done the fogging activities in Iskandar Muda Airport and housing area in Banda Aceh remote area
- A team from Trauma center of MoH will be deployed following the assessment team
- Administration team will be deployed to support the Dinas Kesehatan (health office). As many as 3-4 persons per district (11 affected areas) will be fielded for a two-week rotation

WHO Indonesia

- Coordination with Singapore Air Force for transportation needs
- 2 units of ambulance and 42 oxygen tanks have been sent by ship

International Assistance

- China is operating a field hospital in Aceh Besar
