#### Government

#### MOH information

- Provincial health Office temporary premises will be in Jl. Arakundo III, Geuceu Kompleks, in Banda Aceh.

#### Needs:

- The IDPs in Meulaboh needs the ENT medication especially antibiotic ear drops
- Rehabilitation of basic health centers (Puskesmas and Pustu) needed immediately.

### WHO Indonesia

#### Information from Aceh field team

- Meeting in Health Sector Coordination had been set up for every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 10.00 AM, consist of Government, UN, NGO (local and international).
- They will divided into 4 subgroups: hospital (field and supporting hospital); emergency primary health care (mobile clinic, surveillance, prevention, vaccination); psychosocial and mental health; information and logistics (emergency information sharing and logistics management)
- On 7 January 2005, the topic of the meeting will focus on the mapping and come out with the 'wish list' – to share the needs and who can support.
- Very urgent need of TT and ATS. Nine (9) cases of tetanus in adults have been reported.
